



PRELIMINARY
PER CAPITA GRANT PROGRAM ALLOCATIONS
PURSUANT TO PROPOSITION 40
(2002 RESOURCES BOND)
Updated December 13, 2002

The Department of Parks and Recreation has prepared preliminary allocations for Per Capita grants under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 (2002 Resources Bond). The estimates are based on agencies eligible for the 2000 Park Bond, but have been revised to reflect the higher minimum allocations (\$1.2 million for counties and \$220,000 for cities) in the 2002 Resources Bond. **These preliminary allocations should be used only for rough estimating of what your jurisdiction will receive under the 2002 Resources Bond because of the following:**

- The populations used to determine these preliminary allocations are from the Department of Finance E-1 Report as of January 1, 2000 that was used for calculations for Proposition 12 (2000 Park Bond). These preliminary allocations for the 2002 Resources Bond Per Capita grant program will need to be revised with updated populations as of January 1, 2002.
- Calculations are based on eligible cities and districts for the 2000 Park Bond and do not reflect new cities or districts that may have become eligible since January 1, 2000, or reflect districts that have a change in eligibility since January 1, 2000 or changes in overlap allocation plans between counties and regional park districts or districts and cities since January 1, 2000.
- Jurisdictions will have until April 1, 2003 to resolve all jurisdictional overlaps as required by the 2002 Resources Bond. After April 1, 2003 the Department of Parks and Recreation will determine allocations for jurisdictions with unresolved overlaps.
