Subject: Land and Water Conservation Fund Program
Statewide Technical Assistance Workshops
Application Deadline **May 1, 2007**

The Department is pleased to announce the application deadline for the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program (LWCF). The LWCF program provides matching grants for acquisition or development of lands and facilities that provide or support public outdoor recreation. Local units of government, including cities, counties, and districts that are authorized to acquire, develop, operate and maintain park and recreation areas are eligible to apply.

As of the date of this letter, the amount of the State's apportionment for this year is still unknown. Once the Department is informed of its apportionment, it will post the information on its website immediately upon notification.

Regardless of the timing of funding approval notification, applications must be postmarked or delivered to the Department at the address below no later than **May 1, 2007**.

- **Important Note:** the LWCF procedural guide has been updated. For this round of applications, please use the revised guide with the notation, "**Revised January 2007.**" The format of the guide has changed along with updated information; however, the criteria section has not changed.


