Applications for the 2009 competitive cycle of the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) are due March 2, 2009. Below are two different series of LWCF Technical Assistance Workshops for the upcoming 2009 competitive cycle:

**Series 1: An Overview of the LWCF Program and Application Process**

The first series was conducted in late October 2008, and provided an overview of the LWCF program and the application process. Topics included eligible applicants and eligible projects, selecting projects, the application process, resources available, and frequently asked questions.

**Series 2: Submitting a Complete and Competitive LWCF Application**

The second series of LWCF workshops will be offered in January/February 2009. These workshops will focus on the details of the application process. To get the most out of the workshop, attendees are expected to have selected the project(s) for which they will be applying and begun their application(s). Topics will include how to write your grant scope, the 6(f)(3) map requirements, what to include on cost estimates, responding to the project selection criteria, and tips to help you submit a complete application.
