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## **Land and Water Conservation Fund Program (LWCF)**

The LWCF program provides matching grants for acquisition or development of lands and facilities that provide or support public outdoor recreation. Local units of government, including cities, counties, and districts that are authorized to acquire, develop, operate and maintain park and recreation areas are eligible to apply. The amount of the State's apportionment for this year is \$1,740,430.
