

# Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One



City of Avenal

\$530,000

Avenal Neighborhood Park

This project will create the new Avenal Neighborhood Park in the City of Avenal through acquisition and development of a .28 acre parcel, and will include a new half basketball court, picnic area, playground, walking path, lighting, and landscaping.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:


- Create a crushed granite walking path; tree shaded picnic tables; playground with two play areas, one for children ages 2-5 and the other for children ages 5-12; water fountain and buffalo grass.
- Place basketball court away from the playground, and place seating near the playground.
- For safe park use, fence off playground area and close park after hours.
- For park beautification, plant shade trees and incorporate public art. Elementary school children will paint art tiles to be installed in the park.
- At least 50 volunteers will paint tiles for art display, and 30 volunteers will plant landscaping aspects.

The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- Irrigation controller with a soil moisture meter and rain sensor.
- Use pervious surfaces for walking paths.
- At least 10% of construction material will be from recycled material.
- Use drought tolerant, non invasive plants.
- Include solar lighting for basketball court and a percolation area for storm water.

The park will be open 24 hours per day except for playground area. No entrance or membership fees will be charged to use the park.
