

Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One



City of San Jose, Parks, Rec, Neighbor

Buena Vista Park

This project will expand the Buena Vista Park in the City of San Jose through development of an adjacent .15 acre parcel, and construction of a new artificial turf soccer and open space area, picnic area, fencing, and pathways.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:

- Use artificial turf for soccer area and fences to prevent kicked balls into streets, make walking paths comfortable.
- Place walkways around sides of park, plant trees to beautify the park, incorporate fencing to prevent kids from running into streets.

The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- Use 70% energy-efficient irrigation system with automatic rainwater shutoff valves.
- Park will use pervious concrete, asphalt, and pavers. Storm water will be “detained” on site thus reducing flow to sewer.
- City specifies use of greater than 10% recycled products in project. Park items will also be selected for recyclability.
- Use of native drought-resistant plants.
- Park will have bicycle parking, carpool parking spaces, use recycled water, energy efficient lighting, and recycling containers, and will mitigate for any losses as part of project’s biological review.

The park will be open daily from dawn to dusk. No entrance or membership fees will be charged.
