

Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One



City of Porterville

\$2,150,000

Chase Avenue Park

This project will create the new Chase Avenue Park in the City of Porterville through acquisition and development of 2.33 acres, and construction of a new spray park, playground, play field with soccer goals and backstop, walking trail, picnic area, restroom building, parking lot, lighting, and landscaping.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:

- Field designed to accommodate soccer and baseball, spray-park will allow for chalk art. Have covered picnic areas, features for toddler area.
- Position soccer/baseball field away from parking lot and street, locate playground and spray-park near parking lot and restrooms for convenience and visibility.
- Security lighting along perimeter walking trail, ADA features. Park to close at 10:00 PM and open at 6 AM.
- For park beautification, Incorporate plants, flowers, and shade trees into park design. Water fountain concept represented by spray-park.
- Children and youth will create art tiles to be installed in the park.


The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- Irrigation system will feature manually adjustable controllers and rain sensor.
- Bio-swale with soil and vegetation to trap and filter storm water.
- More than 10% of construction materials will be recycled.
- Park will feature native and drought-tolerant vegetation. Native vegetation along river will be retained.
- Energy efficient lighting, low flow spray-park nozzles, shade structure to reduce evaporation, and tree planting to reduce heat island effect

The park will be open daily from 6 AM – 10 PM. No entrance or membership fees will be charged.
