

Sacramento Area Workshop Information

Directions:

From Sacramento, using I-80 East/Reno: take the Douglas Blvd. East Exit, follow it until it dead ends into Granite Bay State Park. Pass the Entrance Station, then at the 2nd stop from the kiosk turn right, then turn immediately left.

From Sacramento, using Hwy 50 East: take the Folsom Exit, turn left (North) on Folsom, drive for about 6 miles and at Folsom/Douglas Blvd. intersection turn right, follow until it dead ends into Granite Bay State Park. Pass the Entrance Station, then at the 2nd stop from the kiosk turn right, then turn immediately left.

Call the entrance station at (916) 791-2902 if need for additional directions.

Parking:

Free parking available in open area before you get to the Activity Center. Free parking is also available in the lot by the Activity Center.

Restaurant locations:

Off of Douglas Blvd. by Raleys there are several restaurants.

Fresno Area Workshop Information

Directions:

Using 99 South: take exit 132B toward Fresno St. Civic Center. Stay straight to go onto 99-South. Turn left on Fresno Street; make U-turn at O Street onto Fresno Street. Facility is on the right.

Using 99 North: Take exit 132B. Turn right onto Fresno Street. Turn left on Fresno Street; make U-turn at O Street onto Fresno Street. Facility is on the right.

Parking directions:

There is 2-hour metered parking around the building and there is some free parking in the back. Participants may have to feed the meters during the workshop breaks.

Restaurant locations:

Several restaurants are located within 3 blocks at the Galleria on N and Kern Streets.

Oakland Area Workshop Information

Directions:

Using 238 N toward I-880: Merge onto I-880 N via the exit on the left toward Oakland. Take I-980 E toward Walnut Creek/CA 24. Take the 11th Street exit, exit 1A, toward 14th Street. Go straight toward Castro Street. Turn right onto 14th Street/International Drive.

Using I-80 West: Take I-580 E toward downtown. Merge onto I-980 W toward downtown Oakland. Take the 18th Street exit, exit 1C, toward 14th Street. Take slight left onto Brush Street. Turn left onto Street/International Drive.

Parking:

There is garaged parking 2 blocks away - get there early. Street parking is limited.

Restaurant locations:

There are a wide range of restaurants within 1-2 blocks in the quad area around the location.

San Diego Area Workshop Information

Directions:

From San Diego, using CA-94 E toward Lemon Grove: Take the Lemon Grove Avenue exit, exit 8. Keep right at the fork to go on Lemon Grove Avenue. Turn right to stay on Lemon Grove Avenue.

From Los Angeles, using US-101 S: US-101 S becomes I-5 S. Keep left to take I-805 S. Merge onto CA-94 E. Take the Lemon Grove Avenue exit, exit 8. Keep right at the fork to go on Lemon Grove Avenue. Turn right to stay on Lemon Grove Avenue.

Parking Directions:

There is free off-street parking directly across the street at the Recreation Center. There is also plenty of free street parking as well. (There are schools at either end of School Lane, so lots of drop-offs and pick-ups before and after school.) Do not park in the the lot behind the Bank of America (next door).

Restaurant locations:

There are a wide variety of restaurants from .02 - .34 miles from the Community Center, covering multiple tastes.

Chino Hills Area Workshop Information

Directions:

From Los Angeles, using US 101 South, which becomes 5 South: Merge onto CA-91 E via exit 114B toward Riverside. Take the Imperial Hwy/CA-90 exit. Turn left onto South Imperial Hwy/CA-90 W. Turn right onto Esperanza Rd, which becomes Hidden Hill Rd. Bear left on Hidden Hills Rd. Turn right on Hidden Glen Lane.

From San Diego, using I-5 North: Merge onto CA-133 N via exit 95 toward Riverside. Merge onto CA-241 N via exit 14B toward Riverside. Merge onto CA-241 N via exit 14B toward Riverside. Take the Yorba Linda Blvd/Weir Canyon Rd. exit and turn right onto N. Wier Canyon Rd (which becomes Yorba Linda Blvd. Turn right on New River Rd. Turn left on Esperanza Rd, which becomes Hidden Hill Rd. Bear left on Hidden Hills Rd. Turn right onto Hidden Glen Ln.

Parking:

Parking is free in the large parking lot near the intersection of Peyton Drive & Boys Republic Drive. Free parking is also available in the parking structure by City Hall. Participants need to look for unmarked parking spaces in that structure. A few of them are reserved, but most are open and free.

Restaurant locations:

There are a wide variety of restaurants from 02 - .34 miles from the Library.
