

# Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One

La Mirada Park

This project will create the new La Mirada Park in the City of Los Angeles through acquisition and development of a .17 acre parcel, and construction of a new path, lawn area, gathering space, children's play area, native and seasonal garden, and public art.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:


- Create a place for seniors, create a place to see and enjoy nature, limit picnic tables.
- Create two entry points in the perimeter fence at La Mirada and Serrano Avenues, place the lawn area in front of the park, locate children's area inside the park, provide shaded seating at the northern edge, maintain screening along the residential edge, place seating area in the shade.
- Lighting for night security, install a 6' tall perimeter fence with lockable gates, limit park hours to daylight, minimize "tagable" surfaces, use defensive planting along the perimeter.
- For park beautification, incorporate public art designed by residents such as sculptural game tables, garden art pieces, and quotes from residents on permeable pavers.
- Use native flora as an educational tool
- Up to 30 residents will plant native plants and other additions.

The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- Water efficient irrigation system with rain sensor and soil moisture meter and/or smart controller.
- Combination of permeable surfaces and a planted bioswale to collect runoff.
- 10% recycled materials will be used to construct the park.
- Include non-invasive, drought tolerant plants.
- Energy efficient outdoor lighting, light colored paving, locally sourced materials, capture runoff from off site sources.

The park will be open during daylight hours from approximately 7 AM - 8 PM. No fees or membership will be charged for entry to the park.
