

Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One



Los Angeles Neighborhood Initiative
New Park - West Boulevard

\$762,500

This project will create a new West and Adams Boulevard Park through development of .21 acres in the City of Los Angeles and construction of a children's playground, picnic area, landscaping, lighting, and fencing.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:

- Create a beautiful green environment for all age groups, colorful playground equipment, decorative fencing.
- Place tot lot at widest part of park, place benches near tot lot, place picnic/chess area in corner furthest from tot lot. Picnic area will include chess tables for seniors.
- Use anti-vagrancy seating, provide adequate night lighting, fully fence the park.
- 30-50 residents will plant trees and plants.

The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- Use water sensitive irrigation system with rain sensors and soil moisture meters.
- Incorporate pervious surfaces.
- Minimum of 10% recycled materials will be utilized.
- Use native, drought tolerant plants.
- Reduce urban heat island effect, bio-swales, channel runoff from adjacent structures and lots through the park, solar powered lighting.

The park will be open daily from dawn to dusk. No fees will be charged to use the park.
