

Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One

Ord & Yale Street Park

This project will create the new Ord and Yale Street Park in the City of Los Angeles through acquisition and development of a .58 acre parcel, and construction of a new playground, plaza and performing arts space, fitness trail and fitness zone, upper viewing terrace, game tables, and restroom.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:

- Space for tai-chi and martial arts. Café/concession, seating and shade arbors, community bulletin board.
- Place play equipment and fitness zone along Eastern edge, and place shade seating structures next to children's play area. Locate entry plaza/performance space, restrooms, concession area, and game tables closest to the street. Place viewing terrace at highest point of park, connect fitness trail between park amenities.
- Use accessible trails and ramps for steep hillside area, safety lighting throughout park, and fencing around park. Create hillside cultural gardens, use mix of native and ornamental plants including citrus/fruit trees. Fencing to mimic bamboo, no chain link fencing.
- For park beautification, distinctive Chinese cultural art will be integrated in the entry gate, performance space with overhead arbor, viewing terrace and seep fountain at the top of the park, and the bamboo grove adjacent to library. Red lacquer benches and carved stone decorative seating throughout the park for reading areas.
- 20 Los Angeles Conservation Corps members will assist with construction and landscaping.


The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- Subterranean drip irrigation using a controller with rain and moisture sensors.
- Permeable surfaces for landscape, trails, and plaza; collection channel to allow runoff to infiltrate.
- 10% recycled materials to be used for construction of park.
- Use non-invasive, drought tolerant plants.
- LED lighting, solar panels, light colored paving, locally sourced materials, collect runoff from site, low flow plumbing fixtures.

The park will be open daily from 7 AM to 9 PM. No fees for entry or membership will be required to use the park.
