

Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One



City of Paso Robles

\$2,575,000

Paso Robles Uptown Family Park

This project will create the new Paso Robles Uptown Family Park in the City of Paso Robles through development of a 1.3 acre parcel. A new water play area, learning play area, performing arts amphitheater, nature trail and walkways, picnic areas, restroom, parking lot, fencing, and landscaping will be developed.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:

- Create an interpretive “walking story book” theme crushed granite nature trail. Garden design to profile Chumash agricultural practices.
- Take advantage of site’s natural slope contour. Create a boulder climbing zone and tree-house. Create a shaded family picnic area.
- Place parking lot in upper left corner of parcel, place nature trail at the perimeter, place water feature and house style structure in the center, use hillside for the climbing zone, place amphitheater next to the buildings, place a pedestrian entrance near the public housing complex.
- For safe use, include 24-hour lighting, emergency phone call station, low perimeter fencing to protect children, and a tall “green wall” as an attractive off-ramp barrier.
- “Green wall” to include vertical planting with a mural or mosaic.
- For park beautification, include public art created by children, plant lots of trees and flowers.
- 12 corps members will participate during construction, 40 community service youth will assist during construction, 20-40 resident volunteers will participate in work days, 25 elementary school students will participate at least one work session, 12 youth will focus on a signature project.

The project will include these sustainable techniques:

- State of the art irrigation system with soil moisture sensors and on site recycling.
- Use pervious surfaces for parking lot and nature trails and bio-swales.
- Project construction bid proposals will be required to 1) include a minimum 10% recycled materials, and 2) guarantee that all recoverable materials will be separated and recycled.
- Drought tolerant, non-invasive, native plants.
- Solar powered lights, 20% of materials will be locally sourced, skylights in restrooms, low/no flow plumbing fixtures, natural ventilation of restrooms.

The park will be open daily from dawn to dusk. Access to the park will be free except for a minor fee structure for reserved use of the group picnic areas of amphitheater for special events. A voluntary donation program will be established for the community garden space.
