## Directions

March 5, 2008 – Folsom/Granite Bay

### From Sacramento:




- Take I-80 east towards Reno.
- Take the Douglas Boulevard exit and head east.
- Continue east until the road deadends into the Folsom Lake SRA.
- After the kiosk, go to the 2nd stop sign, turn right and then immediately left. The workshop will be held at the Folsom-Granite Bay Activity Center.

### From Hwy 50:

- Exit at Folsom Boulevard and go north.
- Continue for about 5-6 miles, turning right onto Douglas Boulevard. The road deadends into the Folsom Lake SRA.
- After the kiosk, go to the 2nd stop sign, turn right and then immediately left. The workshop will be held at the Folsom-Granite Bay Activity Center.



March 25, 2008 – Milpitas



### From I-680:

- Take the Calaveras Blvd/Highway 237 off-ramp.
- Proceed east on Calaveras Blvd to Downing Road.
- Turn left on Downing road into Ed Levin County Park and follow signs to the RTP workshop at the County Parks Training Center.


## Directions

### March 26, 2008 – Fresno/Clovis

#### From Hwy 168:



- Take the Bullard Avenue off ramp.
- Take Bullard Road east and jog onto 5<sup>th</sup> St.
- Proceed to 1233 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Clovis, CA
- The workshop is in the Public Safety Community Room at the Clovis Police Department.



### April 15, 2008 – Malibu



#### From Hwy 101 N:


- Take the Las Virgenes Road exit (Exit 32) toward Malibu Canyon.
- Turn left onto Las Virgenes Road.
- The workshop will be held at Malibu Creek State Park, which is located at 1925 Las Virgenes Road in Calabasas.
- The nearest major cross street is Mulholland Hwy.

### April 16, 2008 – Lake Perris

#### From I-215:



- Take the Ramona Expressway off-ramp.
- Go east on Ramona Expressway to Lake Perris Drive.
- Go left on Lake Perris Drive and follow it into Lake Perris State Recreation Area.
- At the entrance station ask directions to the RTP workshop.



## Directions

April 24, 2008 - Redding



### From I-5:

- Take the Cypress Avenue off-ramp.
- Go west on Cypress ½ mile to Hemsted Drive
- Go right on Hemsted and go two blocks to 355 Hemsted Drive.
- Use the parking lot just before the Bureau of Land Management sign and proceed to the Bureau of Land Management Conference room.

May 28, 2008 - San Diego



### From I-15:

- Take the Friars Road exit and proceed east on Friars Road to Mission Gorge Road.
- Proceed north on Mission Gorge Road for approximately 3 miles. Look for the large wooden “Mission Trails Regional Park” sign at Mission Gorge Road.
- Turn left onto Father Junipero Serra Trail. The Visitor and Interpretive Center parking lot is on the left just before you get to the pipe gate. Arrive at 1 Father Junipero Serra Trail.
