April 29, 2009 – El Dorado Hills CSD
(Classroom)



**1021 Harvard Way
El Dorado Hills, CA 95762**

From Hwy 50:

- Take the El Dorado Hills Blvd. Exit. Merge onto El Dorado Hills Blvd.
- Turn right on Harvard Blvd.
- Make a U-turn at Tah-nee Way onto Harvard Way
- **End at El Dorado Hills CSD**

April 30, 2009 – Folsom/Granite Bay
– Beek's Bight (Non-Motorized)

From Sacramento:

- Take I-80 east towards Reno.
- Take the Douglas Boulevard exit and head east.
- Continue east until the road deadends into the **Folsom Lake SRA**.
- After the kiosk, follow the signs to **Beek's Bight**. The group will gather in the parking lot of Beek's Bight.

From Hwy 50:

- Exit at Folsom Boulevard and go north.
- Continue for about 5-6 miles, turning right onto Douglas Boulevard. The road deadends into the **Folsom Lake SRA**.
- After the kiosk, follow the signs to **Beek's Bight**. The group will gather in the parking lot of Beek's Bight.







– Mammoth Bar OHV (Motorized)

Location

The entrance to Mammoth Bar is located on Old Foresthill Road. The easiest access is off of Interstate 80 north of Auburn. Take the Highway 49 exit off I-80 towards Coloma. Travel about 3 miles to the Old Foresthill Road. Turn right on Old Foresthill and the entrance is about 1.5 miles on the left.


May 20, 2009 – Agoura Hills/

From Hwy 101 N:

- Take the Lost Hills Road exit (Exit 33).
- Turn left onto Lost Hills Road.
- Turn right onto Agoura Road.
- Turn left onto Malibu Hills Road. **End at Agoura Hills/Calabasas Community Center Agoura Room**



May 21, 2009 – Calabasas/
Malibu Creek State Park
(Non-Motorized)



**1925 Las Virgenes Road
Calabasas, CA 91302**

From Hwy 101 N:

- Take the Las Virgenes Road exit (Exit 32) toward Malibu Canyon.
- Turn left onto Las Virgenes Road.
- The field exercise will be held at **Malibu Creek State Park**. The nearest major cross street is Mulholland Hwy.

May 21, 2009 – Gorman (Motorized)



From I-5 N:

- Take the Gorman exit.
- Turn left at the stop sign onto Gorman School Road, traveling under the freeway.
- Make a right onto Peace Valley Road. The entrance to the park is one mile north on Peace Valley Road, to the left.

From I-5 S:

- Take the Gorman exit.
- Turn right at the bottom of the ramp.
- Turn right onto Peace Valley Road. The entrance to the park is one mile north on Peace Valley Road, to the left.
