RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION Historic State Capitol Commission

WHEREAS, prior to the 1976 California Capitol Restoration Project there existed no guidelines or advisory authority to preserve and maintain the historic integrity of the Capitol and its artifacts, antiques, and art; and,

WHEREAS, by Joint Resolution of the Legislature in February 1976, a Historic State Capitol Commission was authorized to protect the California Capitol's historical and architectural integrity in perpetuity; and,

WHEREAS, in 1998 the Historic State Capitol Commission reconvened with new members and recommitted itself to establishing advisory and working relationships with other stewards of the Historic State Capitol including the California Capitol Historic Preservation Society; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission recently completed its longstanding proposal to complete signage for the portraits of California's Governor and continues to work on a variety of ongoing programs and issues, including the Capitol View Protection Plan and the concern over proliferation of memorials in Capitol Park; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission promotes the principles of sustainable design in order to lay the foundation for the Greening of the State Capitol Project; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission is given to the Historic State Capitol Commission for its outstanding efforts to preserve and maintain the historic integrity of California's Capitol, enhance the Capitol's collection of art and artifacts, and prepare the Capitol to meet the needs of future Californians; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to the Historic State Capitol Commission.
