- Listed in the National Register of Historic Places
- The Bing Kung Tong Building, constructed in 1926, is a contributor to the Isleton Asian-American National Register Historic District. A multi-purpose community center, the building served as a school, chamber of commerce, news office, and meeting hall. The Tong provided protection and regulation for Chinese-American operated businesses, organized community gatherings and celebrations such as Chinese New Year, and served as a vital link to China.

Project Scope:

- Remove old roof, replace deteriorated members, and insulate attic and walls.
- Restore or replace windows as needed, replace exterior metal siding where needed. Stabilize and seismically retrofit building, and brace second floor.
- Upgrade electrical system
- Restore interior front and back stairwells, including landings
