- The Congregation Talmud Torah of Los Angeles (Breed Street Shul) consists of a brick synagogue, designed by architect Abram M. Edelman. Constructed in 1922 in the Byzantine Revival style, the Breed Street Shul is the last remaining synagogue in the area.
