## Casa Grande

### San Jose, CA

- Listed in the National Register of Historic Places
- The Casa Grande was constructed between 1850 and 1854 by Francis Myers under the direction of Henry Wager Halleck. The building was originally planned as a one-story brick structure to be used as a hotel for the New Almaden mining community. Halleck had the structure enlarged to a two to three story residence for the mine manager. The building served as the mine manager's residence until 1926.

### Project Scope

- Restore the exterior including roofs, walls, windows, doors, and veranda.
- Restore interior walls, floors, and decorative architectural elements.
- Upgrade plumbing, electrical, heating, ventilation and air conditioning, and fire protection systems.
