- Listed in the California Register of Historical Resources
- The Casa del Rey Golf and Country Clubhouse (now called the Pogonip Clubhouse) is associated with Santa Cruz promoter (and later mayor) of the City of Santa Cruz, Fred Swanton. The golf course opened in 1912; shortly thereafter Swanton declared bankruptcy and the club was operated under the auspices of the Santa Cruz Golf and Country Club until it closed in 1930. In 1935, the facility re-opened as the Pogonip Polo Club. This revival was brought about by Dorothy Deming Wheeler, who was instrumental in founding the Pacific Coast Women's Polo Association.

### Project Scope:

- Remove non-historic elements which have been added over time including the closed-in porch and interior walls;
- Seismically upgrade building, repair roof system and chimney, and install new roof;
- Expand & upgrade restrooms; install new plumbing and fixtures; remodel kitchen kitchen;
- Restore flooring, interior wood paneling, doors, and historic light fixtures.
