It is situated along the Santa Ana River and located behind Mt. Rubidoux just west of charming historic downtown Riverside. For overnight or extended stays, guests can choose from two great campgrounds that suit the needs of tent and RV campers alike. For equestrian campers, the California Trails and Greenways Conference has secured private access to the Hidden Valley Wildlife Area. Set on 1,500 scenic acres along the Santa Ana River and located approximately 25 minutes from the Riverside Convention Center, Hidden Valley provides access to 25 miles of hiking and equestrian trails. Non-potable water and porta-potties are available for campers. No other facilities are provided. Camping is \$10/night.
