

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AN INITIAL STUDY/ NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE PROPOSED

MOUNT DIABLO ROAD AND TRAIL MANAGEMENT PLAN

Date: January 26, 2016

The California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) has prepared and intends to adopt a Negative Declaration for the proposed project, in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and State CEQA Guidelines. DPR is the lead agency for the proposed project under CEQA.

PROJECT LOCATION: MDSP is located in the north end of the Diablo Range, in the Coast Range Geomorphic Province, surrounded by the cities of Clayton, Walnut Creek, and Danville in Contra Costa County. Presently, MDSP encompasses about 18,000 acres of parkland. Township 1S, Range 1E of Section 6, Mount Diablo Meridian, USGS 7.5' Clayton, CA Quadrangle.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT: DPR proposes to adopt a Road and Trail Management Plan describing the existing roads and trails of Mount Diablo State Park and providing specific direction for management and operations in the future, located in Contra Costa County; adjacent to the south of the City of Clayton, California.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: The Initial Study/Negative Declaration (as appended to the Road and Trail Management Plan) is being circulated for public review and comment for a period of 30 days, beginning January 26, 2016 and ending February 26, 2016.
