

Erosion Control and Restoration


American Conservation Experience (ACE)

- Blended the “seam” and shaped the backslope
- Seeded uphill and downhill slopes
- Secured jute netting over “seam”
- Tread work
- Placed felled debris on slopes for aesthetics
- Finishing touches on realignment
- Planted oak trees


