Volunteer Trail Safety Patrol Program Basics – Quick Summary

- ✿ Agency ambassadors, eyes & ears
- ✿ Promote, influence, and improve proper trail etiquette by park/preserve visitors
- ✿ Provide ‘detailed’ trail condition reports to staff
- ✿ Trained and informed volunteers who assist with other projects and events
- ✿ Constituents able to ‘give back’ to their favorite parks/preserves and participate in a program that fits their time schedule
- ✿ Opportunity for all user groups

- ✿ Interview – Individual & Group
- ✿ Follow-up



Volunteer Trail Safety Patrol

When Problems Occur...

- ✿ Identify the Problem/Incident
- ✿ Check the Program Handbook/Training Materials
 - Reference
 - Potential Updates
- ✿ Discussion
 - Phone call/Email
 - Meeting – Bring in Field Supervisor
- ✿ Plan of Action
- ✿ Follow-up



Volunteer Trail Safety Patrol Examples – Group Discussion

- ✿ Unprofessional Reporting
- ✿ Chasing/Following an Ordinance Violator(s)
- ✿ Unprofessional Contact with Visitor(s)
- ✿ Performing Duties Outside of Program Parameters
- ✿ Others...
