The lands and facilities of San Diego Coast District of the Department of Parks and Recreation are hereby subject to the following provisions:

This Superintendent's Order is issued pursuant to the following:

On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom issued a State of Emergency Proclamation and Executive Order N-25-20 in response to COVID-19. Subsequently, Executive Order N-33-20 was issued directing all residents to heed the current State public health directives, including the directive to stay home or at their place of residence and observe social distancing measures. This Order is directly related to that emergency.

On June 8, 2020, the San Diego County Public Health Officer issued a Public Health Order, which states that each public park and recreation area or facility, shall operate in compliance with the measures set forth in the State COVID-19 Industry Guidance: Campgrounds, RV Parks and Outdoor Recreation.

The beaches, campgrounds, parking areas and restrooms within the San Diego Coast District are open for public use and recreation.

Gatherings and group sports, including but not limited to volleyball and group exercise, are prohibited.
