The Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) has rescheduled the Advisory Planning Commission (APC) public environmental scoping hearing on the General Plan Revision and EIR/Kings Beach Pier Reconstruction Project EIR/EIS from February 10 to April 13, 2016. Please check the TRPA website 1 week prior to confirm the place and time for the public hearing. The TRPA and CEQA scoping periods have been extended to April 15, 2016; the original scoping period extended from December 22, 2015 through February 12, 2016.

In December 2015, California Department of Parks and Recreation (State Parks), in partnership with the California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy), initiated a revision to the Kings Beach SRA General Plan and proposed a pier reconstruction project at the site. Current planning efforts include gathering public comment and existing site data, and providing a comment opportunity on the appropriate scope of the environmental document.
