The General Plan recommends that opportunities for the following recreation & interpretive activities be expanded:

- Motorized and human-powered boating
- Wildlife watching and nature observation
- Trail activities such as bicycling, hiking, running, and orienteering
- Safe public access to the river, including for persons with mobility challenges
- RV and tent camping for groups and individuals, as well as overnight lodging
- Large and small outdoor social, interpretive and cultural events for groups and families
- Information and facilities serving regional recreation opportunities

The Public Input Process

- ✓ Meeting #1 (February, 2013)
Provided project overview. Reviewed resource inventory.
Collected information. Listened to your issues and concerns.
- ✓ Meeting #2 (June, 2014)
Presented planning options and preferred alternative.
Listened to your concerns as part of the CEQA Public Review process.
- Public Review Period (February 8, 2016 through March 24, 2016)**
Publish the Draft Plan/EIR and collect your comments.
- Respond to public comments and prepare final EIR (Spring 2016).
- Meeting #3 (Spring-summer 2016)
California Parks and Recreation Commission considers certifying the EIR and approving the General Plan.
