PUBLIC MEETING INVITATION **CUYAMACA RANCHO STATE PARK** **GENERAL PLAN**

California State Parks (CSP) invites you to the second public meeting for the Cuyamaca Rancho State Park General Plan.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide an opportunity for the general public to learn about alternatives that CSP has generated after obtaining input from the public and stakeholders with interest in the Park's management and development. In addition, CSP staff will update our progress through the general plan process.

The General Plan Team is comprised of CSP staff including landscape architects, environmental scientists, historians, archaeologists, planners, interpreters, rangers and maintenance staff. They will be present to gather input and answer questions regarding park issues of interest to you.

The Team encourages you to further participate in the general plan process by attending the upcoming public meeting as well as visiting the project webpage to remain updated regarding the future availability of the Preliminary General Plan/Draft Environmental Impact Report. We also welcome e-mailing any additional ideas and/or comments.

A General Plan is mandated for all state park units by the California Public Resources Code. The plan becomes the primary management document for State Park units, establishing their purpose and management direction for the future. The plan does not provide specific designs or locations of facilities but does provide a vision for the park and guidelines for park use, management and development.
