**NOTICE OF HEARING ON APRIL 5, 2003  
CALIFORNIA STATE PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Park and Recreation Commission, pursuant to authority contained in Sections 539, 5002.3, 5019.50, 5080.03, 5080.20, et al of the Public Resources Code, Section 11120 et seq. of the Government Code, and pursuant to law, will meet on Saturday, April 5, 2003 at 9:30 a.m. in the Boardroom of the Tahoe City Public Utility District Administration Offices, 221 Fairway Drive, Tahoe City, California. The meeting facility is wheelchair accessible.

Agenda items include consideration and action on the Department of Parks and Recreation's recommendation for approval of the Preliminary General Plan and Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for Donner Memorial State Park, and consideration and action on the Department's proposal to honor the late assemblyman and leading environmentalist Edwin L. Z'berg with the addition of his name to Sugar Pine Point State Park.

The agenda will also include the determination of compatibility with the unit classification and general plan requirements of Old Town San Diego State Historic Park with the Department's proposal to execute a new contract for the specialty concession located in the 2611 San Diego Ave. building (a.k.a. Dodson's Corner), including proposed uses as a food service/restaurant and/or retail shop concession, and the on-site sale of alcoholic beverages with bona-fide meals in the food service/restaurant operation.
