This center provide hands-on boating training annually to over 4,500 youth and first-time boaters and over 13,000 boat rental customers from the Oakland area. The tour also includes a visit to the Encinal Boat Ramp, which is a project funded by Boating and Waterways Grant Program in Alameda, CA.
