PROPOSER RFP QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following are responses from the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to proposer questions submitted by April 23, 2007, for the Overnight Surf Camps and Private Surf Schools Request for Proposals (RFPs).

1. **San Diego Surf Academy #1:** Under what circumstances will the State renew the surf camp contract after five years?

RESPONSE: The circumstances for renewing the surf camp contract after five years are unknown. Prior to offering a new contract or contract extension, the State does an evaluation as to the appropriateness of the concession. The State, at a minimum, considers current regulations and laws, economic feasibility, public input, and incumbent concessionaire performance (for contract extension). In a contract that is five years with a five year option to renew, at the State's discretion, the State is not obligated to offer the additional five-year extension.

2. **Eli Howard Surf School #1:** After five years has the concessionaire fulfilled the contract obligation? Does the concessionaire then have the right to cease operations?

RESPONSE: Yes, after five years the concessionaire has fulfilled the contract obligation. Yes, the concessionaire has the right to cease operations after five years.
