Day Use Hours

In accordance with provisions of Section 4326 of Title 14, California Code of Regulations, for the protection of the health and safety of persons, property and resources the lands and facilities of Capital district State Park units are hereby closed to public use, entry, and occupancy except as provided below. Daily parks hours are posted at major public use areas and entry gates.

Regular day use hours for Old Sacramento State Historic Park are:

SUNRISE TO SUNSET seven days a week year round

Regular day use hours for the exterior grounds of Sutter's Fort State Historic Park, the California State Indian Museum as bordered by "K" Street on the north, 26th Street on the west, "L" Street on the south, and 28th Street on the east are:

SUNRISE TO SUNSET seven days a week year round

Regular day use hours for Sutter's Fort State Historic Park buildings and interior grounds (2701 "L" Street, Sacramento CA), the California State Indian Museum interior facilities (2618 "K" Street Sacramento CA), and the exterior grounds and interior facilities of the Leland Stanford Mansion State Historic Park (800 "N" Street, Sacramento CA) are:

10:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M seven days a week year round except New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day

Regular day use hours for the buildings and facilities of Railtown 1897 State Historic Park (18115 5th Avenue, Jamestown, CA) are:

9:30 a.m. to 4:30 P.M April through October, seven days a week

10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. November through March, seven days a week except New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day

Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent or designee, Capital District, 101 "J" Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
