CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PROHIBITION

In accordance with provisions of Section 4326 of Title 14, California Code of Regulations, for the protection of the health and safety of persons, property, and resources in California State Parks Capital District the consumption of alcoholic beverages is hereby prohibited beginning February 1, 2016. This policy is effective in all day use areas and closed areas of the Capital District to include: Old Sacramento State Historic Park including the Pioneer Grain Mill area of the Sacramento River Parkway, the Riverfront Beach Area, the California State Railroad Museum, Leland Stanford Mansion State Historic Park, Sutter's Fort State Historic Park, and the California State Indian Museum.


"Alcoholic beverage" means any alcohol, spirits, wine, beer and every liquid or solid containing alcohol, spirits, wine, or beer.

"Consumption" means the act of consuming, and "consume" is defined as "to eat or drink up."

Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent or designee, Capital District, 101 J Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
