CLOSED/PROHIBITED AREA

In accordance with provisions of Section 4326 of Title 14, California Code of Regulations, for the protection of the health and safety of persons, property and resources parts of Riverfront Park and the Sacramento/American River Parkway in Old Sacramento State Historic Park are hereby closed to the public beginning February 1, 2016. Closed Areas are defined as:

**Riverfront Park**

-Northern closed area bordered by the "I" Street Bridge to the North, Sacramento River to the west, Retaining wall on to the west side of the Sacramento River Multi- Use Recreation Trail to the east and Latitude 38.584949 to the south.

-Southern closed area bordered by Latitude 38.584128 to the north, Sacramento River to the west, Retaining wall located along Longitude -121.505953 to the east and "J" Street Dock to the south.


**Sacramento/American River Parkway**

-Closed area is around the Pioneer Grain Mill at 500 Jibboom Street and is bordered by Latitude 38.590835 to the north, Sacramento River to the west, "I" Street Bridge to the south and the connection of Lat/Long 38.586 399/-121.505206 to Lat/Long 38.587662/-121.5051 to Lat/Long 38.587845/-121.505086 to Lat/Long 38.588764/-121.505008 to Lat/Long 38.590835/-121.505389 to the east.

Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent or designee, Capital District, 101 J Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
