Storage of Personal Property Prohibited

In accordance with provisions of Section 4326 of title 14, California Code of Regulations, for the protection of the health and safety of persons, property, and resources within the lands and facilities of Capital District State Park Units it is unlawful and a public nuisance for any person to store, or leave unattended, any personal property including camp paraphernalia, carts, or luggage.

"Store" means to put aside or accumulate for use when needed, to put for safekeeping, to place or leave in any location unattended.

Per California Civil Code § 2080.1 and § 2080.7 respectively, personal property stored on or in Capital District lands or facilities will be immediately removed and stored by State Park Peace Officers as found or abandoned property. If unclaimed the property will be disposed of per those sections.


Persons observed by State Park Peace Officers violating this order will be subject to citation or arrest.

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Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent or designee, Capital District, 101 J Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
