**CAMPING PROHIBITED**

In accordance with provisions of Section 4326 of title 14, California Code of Regulations, for the protection of the health and safety of persons, property, and resources within the lands and facilities of Capital District State Park Units it is unlawful and a public nuisance for any person to camp on the grounds of any Capital District unit.

**Definitions:** Per California Code of Regulation Title 14 4301(u) camping is defined as "Erecting a tent, shelter, or arranging bedding or both for the purposes of, or in such a way as will permit, remaining overnight." Per CCR T14 14 4451(a) No person shall camp, as defined in Section 4301(u), in any unit except in area provided for that purpose.

**Capital District Camping Prohibitions**


**CCRT14 4326(a) 670-16-008:**

- (a) No unit or portion of a unit within the Capital District is available for camping at any time.

Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent or designee, Capital District, 101 J Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
