

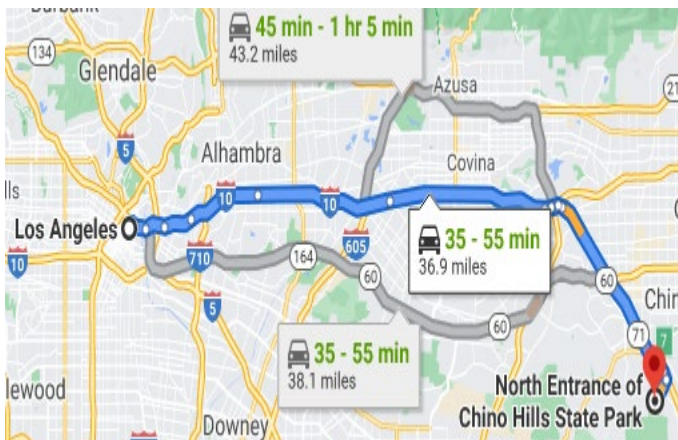
## ENDLESS ADVENTURES AT 19 STATE PARKS



# Chino Hills State Park

**55 minutes from Los Angeles**

Chino Hills State Park is a premier natural open space in the hills around the Santa Ana Canyon. The park has more than 14,000 acres of rolling, grassy hills and valleys, dotted with stands of oaks and sycamores. Because of its great variety of habitats and microclimates, Chino Hills State Park is an ideal location for observing many wildlife species native to Southern California. [View Park Brochure](#)



### Day Trip Option

Chino Hills State Park offers 43 hiking trails, which are open to hiking, biking and equestrian riding. Trails range from 0.8 miles to 16.5 miles, and from 459 to 2,240 feet above sea level. The Bane Canyon Loop Trail, a 5.8-mile loop, is one of the park's most popular trails and features beautiful wildflower viewing during the spring bloom.
