STORM CLOSURE

1. Effective March 14, 2005, the following areas of Hungry Valley State Vehicular Recreation Area shall remain closed due to storm damage: South Entrance from the State Park Boundary to the east end of Aliklik Campground, North Grasslands, the Practice Track and the following trails Gorman, Sterling Canyon, Steer Bones, Backbone, and Flying W. The backcountry trails, though open, remain more challenging than the current rating system. This is due to storm damage caused by the recent rain. Hazardous conditions exist as a result of erosion of roads and trails, as well as down trees and other hazards. All other areas of the park are open for use. Please ride within your abilities and your OHVs capabilities.
2. This order shall remain in effect until public safety and protection of the resource can be assured.
3. Exceptions to this order will only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Hungry Valley District, PO Box 1360, Lebec, CA 93243-1360.
4. Nothing in this order shall affect any existing contract or property rights.
5. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provision of law.
