



# SOUTH FORK SMITH RIVER ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

**Project Info:**  
 This project includes the replacement of the existing 1948 steel arch bridge (George E. Tryon Bridge) with a new 231-foot Concrete Arch Bridge and approaches for the FHWA Central Federal Lands Highway Division (CFLHD). Located along the county road, known as South Fork Smith River Road in northwestern California, it begins at the intersection of US-199 near Hiouchi, California. The Bridge Roadway clear width is being increased from an existing 24' to 32'-4" to allow for a pedestrian/bicycle walkway.
