## Nature Walks at MacKerricher State Park

California State Parks and the non-profit Mendocino Area Parks Association present free Saturday guided nature walks at MacKerricher State Park November 22 through December 20, 2014. Join Park Interpreter Fred Andrews for a natural history walk at Lake Cleone. Learn about some of the interesting birds and plants at the park. **Walks begin at 9 am at the Lake Cleone parking lot on Saturday, November 22 & 29, and December 6, 13 & 20. Binoculars are available to look at birds. Walks will be between one and one-half hours and two and one-half hours in length.**

Call 707-961-0471 for more information about the Saturday nature walks. Lake Cleone is located in MacKerricher State Park, 3 miles north of Fort Bragg, CA. Take Mill Creek Drive west from Hwy 1 to the lake parking lot.
