Trail Use and Closure, Lake Oroville SRA

In order to ensure the health, safety, and convenience of the public, the following regulations shall apply, in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 4326(a), the following trails and facilities of the Loafer Creek Sub-Unit, Lake Oroville State Recreation Area (LOSRA) shall be closed to the public from 8:00 a.m. Wednesday November 16, 2022 to 5:00 p.m. Friday November 18, 2022.

The following land and trail system at Lake Oroville State Recreation Area will have intermittent closure while conducting a prescribed burn fuel reduction project and will be closed to public use, entry or occupancy:


1. Trail Closures:

- (a) All trails and property located within the Loafer Creek Sub-Unit of LOSRA to include but not limited to the following.
 - i. Roy Rogers Trail
 - ii. Loafer Creek Loop Trail
 - iii. Bike Trail

The above listed temporary closures are in effect for the CalFire, State Park, and Department of Water Resources (DWR) prescribed burn fuel reduction project.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Northern Buttes District, 400 Glen Drive, Oroville, CA 95966.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
