## CANADA GOOSE HUNT FOR FAMILIES SET FOR OCTOBER 3-7

OROVILLE, California State Parks, in conjunction with the Department of Water Resources and the Department of Fish and Wildlife announce the Fall Family Goose Hunt.

The hunt takes place Saturday, October 3rd through Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, at the North and South Thermalito Forebays. Registration for hunting permits starts September 21<sup>st</sup> at the Northern Buttes District office, located at 400 Glen Drive in Oroville from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Permits are available for families (defined as a minimum of one adult age 18+ and one junior hunter and a maximum of two adults with four juniors). A junior hunter is a person aged 18 and under. Only ten hunting parties are allowed each day on a first-come, first-served basis. You must appear in person; no phone in reservations will be accepted.

Gas and electric powered boat motors will be allowed. Hunting hours are 30 minutes before sunrise to 12:00 noon each day. Access by the general public to the North and South Thermalito Forebays will be closed until noon each day of the hunt.

This annual event coincides with the early Canada goose hunt coordinated by the Department of Fish and Wildlife. All bag limits, licenses, waterfowl validations, and method of take shall follow DFW codes and regulations.
