Guided Walks at Lake Oroville Reveal History and Nature

- WHO:** Lake Oroville Nature Walks
- WHAT:** Explore trails around the lake
- WHEN:** Saturdays at 9:00 A.M. sharp
- WHERE:** Meet at Lake Oroville Visitor Center, 917 Kelly Ridge Road, Oroville
- WHY:** Learn about Native presence in the area, discover impact of gold rush on the landscape, and aspects of chaparral flora and fauna.
- ADDITIONAL INFO:** Bring drinking water, trail snacks, camera, or GPS device. Dogs are not allowed on park trails. A one day pass will be provided to hikers. Routes are usually easy to moderate and seldom more than five miles. Walks will proceed if misty or scattered rain is predicted. Steady rain will cancel an event. For more details please call the Lake Oroville Visitor Center at 530-538-2219. One ADA accessible wheelchair walk is scheduled monthly as well.
