Posted Order - Seasonal Fire Restrictions


Due to extreme fire conditions associated with emergency drought conditions, all devices fired by wood or charcoal are prohibited at all times and until further notice within all units of the Northern Buttes District, including:

- Ahjumawi Lava Springs S.P.
- Anderson Marsh S.H.P.
- Bidwell Mansion S.H.P.
- Bidwell-Sacramento River S.P.
- Castle Crags S.P.
- Clear Lake S.P.
- Lake Oroville S.R.A, EXCEPT
in designated cooking grills at
North Forebay Picnic Areas
- McArthur-Burney Falls Memorial S.P.
- Shasta S.H.P.
- Sutter Buttes S.P.
- Weaverville Joss House S.H.P.
- William B. Ide Adobe S.H.P.
- Woodson Bridge S. P.

All devices using charcoal, wood or any other fuel that is NOT gas, pressurized liquid, or jellied petroleum are prohibited in all campgrounds and day use areas. All "Tiki Torch devices" shall also be prohibited. Devices such as manufactured portable campfire units, cooking stoves and lanterns fueled by gas, pressurized liquid, or jellied petroleum are permitted in designated campsites, except all campfires of any type shall be prohibited during extreme red flag conditions as issued by previous Order No. 645-330.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Northern Buttes District Superintendent, 400 Glen Drive, Oroville, CA 95966.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
