Volunteer Duty Statement

HOST INFORMATION
Olompali State Historic Park

1. Host(s) will reside in the area assigned as the designated host location in the Olompali SHP residence area. Host(s) are required to provide and live in their own residential accommodation which must be a self contained unit with indoor cooking, sleeping and sanitary facilities. Pick-up trucks with camper shells and tents will not be allowed. The self contained unit must maintain an attractive outward appearance (no broken windows, etc.). The host site must be kept in a neat and orderly condition. Guests may stay with hosts on an intermittent basis for no more than seven days at a time. The host(s) may have two vehicles on site to be parked in the area designated for that purpose. Host guests may have one vehicle. Host(s) are to have no more than two pets in residence. Exceptions to policy may be requested in writing to be submitted to the Sector Superintendent for review.
2. Generally, the host is expected to be available at the park during park hours. Absences from the park should be coordinated with staff prior to departure to ensure that the public service needs are met.
3. Marin Sector State Park Administration reserves the right to review host performance and to excuse the host from their duties if determined that this is in the best interest of the park and the visiting public.
