Join Brad Barnwell on Saturday August 16, 2014 for a bird walk along Cole Creek, Kelsey Creek Outlet and Kelsey Slough. The Fall Bird Migration has started and will hopefully produce some interesting transients.

The 2-hour walk will start at the visitor center parking lot at 7:30 AM. The walk will be at a slow pace and cover about 1 mile of paved road and trails. Participants should bring binoculars/scopes, birding guide, water, mosquito repellent, and sun protection.

Park entry fees are waived for those participating in the walk.

Clear Lake State Park is located at 5300 Soda Bay Rd, Kelseyville, CA and entry into the park is free for those attending the walk.
