Creek Exploration Hike Trione-Annadel State Park

SANTA ROSA, CA

Event Date: Sunday, April 2, 2017
Time: 10:00 AM Hike Departure to about 1 PM
Location: Parktrail Drive, Santa Rosa (neighborhood street parking)
Trails: Spring Creek

Come along and explore an active creek habitat! Join Volunteer Interpretive Naturalist John Lynch on a trail route to study the creek, riparian habitats and mid-spring wildflowers. The route will include approximately 450 foot elevation gain over about 4 miles of varied trails. This route begins and ends at Parktrail Drive and may include sighting of an owl and other wildlife.

Wear hiking shoes, layers appropriate for weather, bring water and snack. You might get your feet wet! Trekking poles recommended. Some trails are rocky and uneven. **HEAVY RAIN CANCELS.**

Fee-free hike. No advance reservations needed. There are no restrooms or water the parking areas or along the hike route. Dogs are not allowed.

Directions: from Hoen Avenue eastbound, turn **RIGHT** on Summerfield Road. Parktrail Drive is the second **LEFT**. Park along the street respecting neighbors and driveways. Hike Leader will meet you at the top of Parktrail Drive just beyond the **STOP** sign at the neighborhood trail entrance.
