Who's Singing in the Forest, Canyon or Meadow? Hike Trione-Annadel State Park

SANTA ROSA, CA

Event Date: Saturday, April 8, 2017
Time: 8:00 AM Hike Departure to about 11 AM
Location: Cobblestone Trail Head
Trails: Cobblestone--Orchard

Spring is the best time to develop or improve birding skills and Trione-Annadel, with its varied habitats, is an ideal place for "birding." Learning and practicing birding skills brings more awareness of everything in nature. We will identify at least 10 common birds of the park by sight and sound during this 3.5-mile round-trip moderate hike with some uphill. We'll also look for wildflowers and other wildlife.

Bring binoculars and a field guide if you have them (not required). Wear hiking shoes, layers appropriate for weather, bring water and snack. Trekking poles recommended. Some trails are rocky and uneven. RAIN CANCELS.

Fee-free hike. No advance reservations needed. There are no restrooms or water the parking areas or along the hike route. Dogs are not allowed.

Directions: from Montgomery Drive, turn onto Channel Drive and follow the road approximately ¼ mile to Cobblestone Trail Head parking area (parking on left along creek channel).
