**Posted Order – POST-FIRE Partial Park Closure (Temporary)**

1. Beginning November 5th, 2017 the below listed trails, roads and areas of Trione-Annadel State Park are closed due to the effects of the Nunns Fire until further notice due to a hazard to public safety and resource protection. The attached Closure Map will reflect the closed areas and affected trails. Every effort will be made to post all entrances and access points to the park to notify the public.

CLOSED TRAILS: Schultz Trail, Marsh Trail, Ridge Trail, Rhyolite Trail, Two Quarry Trail, Pig Flat Trail, South Burma Trail, Lawndale Trail, Any unauthorized, unmarked social trails within the park.

OPEN TRAILS & ROADS: Cobblestone Trail, Channel Trail, Steve's S Trail, North Burma Trail, Louis Trail, Lake Trail, Rough-Go Trail, Live Oak Trail, Spring Creek Trail, Orchard Trail Loop, Viet Nam Veteran's Trail, Canyon Trail Fire Road, and Warren Richardson Trail Fire Road

2. EXCEPTIONS:

- a. Employees of California State Parks, authorized volunteers, and any contractors employed by the Department.
  - b. Emergency Personnel (ie: CalFire, CHP, Sheriff, etc.)
3. This is a temporary closure that provides Park resource protection. It provides the park time to recover without being impacted by public use during increased resource susceptibility. It also provides Public Safety to keep visitors out of unsafe areas and minimize Public Safety Personnel from having to enter the areas unnecessarily.
  4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual and residential or property rights.
  5. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Bay Area District Superintendent or their agent, 845 Casa Grande Road, Petaluma, CA, 94954-5804.
  6. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other

provisions of the law.
