Come see what summer has brought to Anderson Marsh State Historic Park

Anderson Marsh State Historic Park holds guided nature walks on the second Saturday of nearly every month. The next scheduled walk will be held on Saturday morning July 9th.

Led by Park Docents Gae Henry and Henry Bornstein, this walk will cover the Cache Creek Nature Trail. Along with a general history and description of the Park, come and view the birds, dragonflies, butterflies and other wildlife and wildflowers that can be found in the Park this time of year.

Bring your binoculars and meet in front of the Ranch House at 8:15am for time to experience the early morning wildlife to be found in the Ranch House and Barn complex yard – walk begins at 8:30am. There is no fee for those attending. There will be a guided tour of the Ranch House after the July walk.
