Space was precious in the covered wagons that carried pioneers to the Golden State, and families only spared room amongst the necessities for their treasures. Family wedding gowns, handmade toys, samplers and portraits capture the spirit of those who traveled to California. Graciously donated by the families in hopes that future generations will understand and appreciate them, Sutter's Fort State Historic Park is proud to share these valued artifacts which tell the stories of the settlers whose families are still a part of the Sacramento Valley.

Recently rediscovered Sutter, Marshall and Gregson artifacts, Gold Rush clothing and images, as well as the Marriage Book from those wed at Sutter's Fort are highlights of this event.

Additionally, in 1928, Captain Charles E. Davis followed the path of the Donner Party, photographing and collecting artifacts which have been attributed to these tragic families. A toy horse from the Breen Family cabin site as well as salt encrusted wheels from the Reed Palace Wagon, abandoned in the Great Salt Lake, and other artifacts from the Donner Party will be on display.
